## **STAGE 1 WATER RESTRICTIONS RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL**

It is imperative that **ALL** GVSUD customers **CONSERVE WATER REGARDLESS OF ITS SOURCE.**

During the current drought conditions, watering with an irrigation system or sprinkler is permitted only **TWICE A WEEK**, on the designated watering day, between the hours of 12:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. to midnight. Excessive water usage is prohibited. Soaker hose, handheld hose, drip irrigation system or 5 gallon bucket is allowed at any time on any day.

The watering days are based on the last digit of your address.

- ◆ **Even numbers (0, 2, 4, 6, 8)**
  - **Water days are Sundays and Thursdays**
  
- ◆ **Odd Numbers (1, 3, 5, 7, 9)**
  - **Watering days are Saturdays and Wednesdays.**

GVSUD requests that the customers practice water conservation and discontinue non-essential water uses.

GVSUD will implement restrictions based on the Edwards Aquifer Authority Critical Period Triggers. San Antonio's newspaper, radio and television stations, as well as the internet, will provide daily aquifer and spring flow levels and restrictions information. As drought conditions continue, citations may be issued to customers who do not follow water conservation guidelines. GVSUD may also turn water off if excessive water wasting is found.
