



STAGE 2 WATER RESTRICTIONS RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL EFFECTIVE: April 13, 2022

General Manager, Pat Allen, has initiated Stage 2 Water Restrictions of the Green Valley Special Utility (GVSUD) Drought Contingency Plan. GVSUD is requiring all customers to reduce water use by 25%.

During Stage 2 Water Restriction customers are required to adhere to the following:

Sprinkler or irrigation systems may water one (1) day per week.

BEFORE 10:00 a.m. or AFTER 8:00 p.m.

Based on the last digit of your address

- **Monday** **0 or 1**
 - **Tuesday** **2 or 3**
 - **Wednesday** **4 or 5**
 - **Thursday** **6 or 7**
 - **Friday** **8 or 9**
- **If there is no street address associated with the property, such as a parkway, or if there is more than one street address associated with a single contiguous property, the watering day is Wednesday.**

Handheld hose, buckers, drip irrigations systems, and soaker hoses that do not spray water in the air are permitted **any day BEFORE 10:00 am or AFTER 8:00 pm.**

All customers are requested to practice water conservation and discontinue all non-essential water uses.

As drought conditions continue, it may be necessary to move to Stage 3 Water Restrictions. Once Stage 3 Water Restrictions are declared a notice will be posted on our website www.GVSUD.org and the notice mailed with the next billing statement.
